School Year Programs: Amanda Fall and Andrew Ely will attend Capitol Hill Ocean Week with 2 local high school students. Special thanks to the sponsors for funding this trip, including Franklin Templeton and Mystic Financial Group.

Public events: The Prints & Pints fundraiser was a success. Andrew attended and commented that fish printing was more difficult than he realized.

Summer Camps: Historically, Project Oceanology has had approximately 300 kids attend summer camp, and for this year, over 450 kids are registered. It is also exciting to have grant funding to make camp available for more kids; tuition assistance is still available for this summer.

Administration/logistics: The seawater system is still awaiting repairs to be completed by Tucker Mechanical. Andrew and Lesley are working to replace Project Oceanology's existing medical insurance for employees this year. A new part-time custodian has been identified.
